The obverse strike of this rare variety of the 'horseman' type coins of Kumara Gupta is exceptional & showpiece of Gupta art, reverse shows many die shadows due to slippage. The obverse legend celebrates the king as the 'Indra' on the face of the Earth.

These coins are reportedly found at Mandasor, the capital of the Aulikaras, a feudatory dynasty to the Guptas. They are struck anonymous, acknowledging only Vishnu and referring to his 'conquest'. It probably has political undertones – Yashodharman of the Aulikara dynasty is known to have defeated the Hunas.

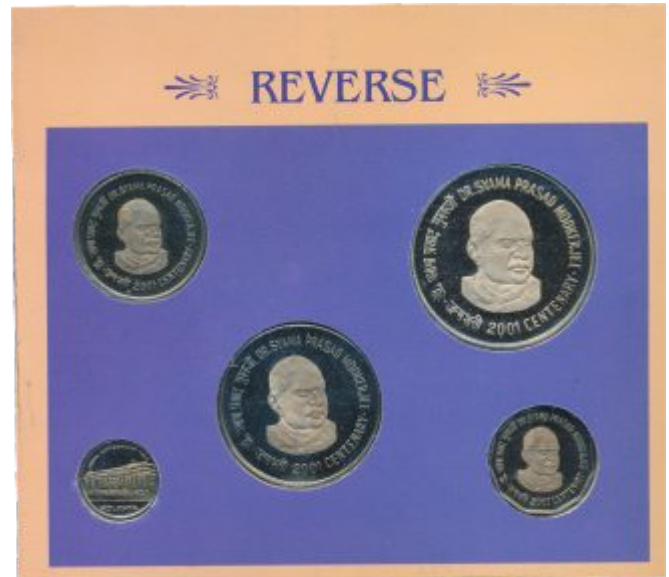

Buyers shall not be entitled to remove lots from the auction room during the course of the auction.
- Each lot shall be at the buyer's risk from the fall of the hammer.
- Any part of the purchase price left outstanding after the action pursuant to Condition 5, shall be paid in full within seven (7) days of the date of auction. Without prejudice to any rights, the auctioneer reserves the right to charge interest on any overdue payment at the rate of 2½% per month.
- A "Buyer's Premium" of 14.25 % (including Service Tax) + Applicable Vat will be charged on the Hammer Price.**
- By making a bid the buyer acknowledges his acceptance of these Conditions and shall be bound by them.
- These Conditions shall take effect and be construed in accordance with Indian law.

Estimates: The estimate figures below each lot are the auctioneer's estimation of an expected price only. These estimates are not representative of a reserve price and are published only as a guide to buyers. Bidders may bid within the estimate or above the estimate, however, bids which are less than the low estimate will not be considered by the auctioneer.
