Naganika was the chief queen of Siri Satakarni, known from her inscription at Nanaghat, which mentions performance of several Vedic sacrifices, including the 'Ashwamedha'. Coins of this type sometimes show a horse on the top of the pillar in railing indicating they might have been struck in commemoration of the sacrifice. Naganika was the first indigenous queen to have coins inscribed in her name.

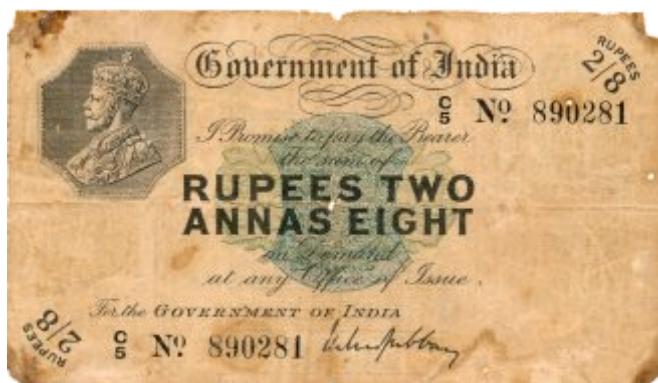
