We are extremely happy to announce our Auction 97 Kolkata. Auction contains total 622 lots, Including 46 lots of Tripura coins collection of very senior collector of Kolkata, 56 Banknotes collection of Advance collector of Paper Money, 131 lots of Major General Aboni Mohan Chaudhari's Collection of Medals, Badges and Honours, and many rarer coins of other collectors.

Major General Aboni Mohan Chaudhuri, FRCS, was a distinguished Army Doctor in the British Army. He had also served in the 2nd World War. Major General Chaudhuri was instrumental in the making

of artificial legs (prosthetic) for wounded soldiers, way back, before the independence. He was awarded Order of the British Empire - OBE (Military Division) medal when he was Major. OBE is awarded for playing a major role in important activity. He belonged to a well-respected Zamindar family of Birbhum District of West Bengal. He set up numerous medical camps through the length and breadth of British India, right from Lahore, Punjab of undivided India to Burma (Myanmar). For his outstanding services he received letter of appreciation from Lord Mountbatten, the former Governor General of India. Post-independence, he received President's award in 1950.

Presented here is a collection of some exceedingly rare and many very important rare and scarce medals, badges/neck badges and honours collected by him for over a long period of time. His collection was inherited by his son Late Shri Tridib Kumar Chaudhuri and later passed on to the next of his kins. Almost all of the medals and badges are in excellent state of preservation, many of them with intact bars and ribbons, glint and original shine.

Apart from the above, this Auction features some great rarities, such as extremely rare Gadhyans of Kakatiyas of Warangal, Western Gangas, the silver Tankas and fractions of the Bengal Sultan, and also an exceedingly rare **Nazrana silver Tanka of Jalal al din Fath Shah**. Besides, an extremely rare Gold Dinar **of Muhammad of Damghan Shah of Madura Sultanate**, Very Rare Gold dinars of Delhi, Bengal and Kashmir Sultanates, Rare Mohurs of Mughal Emperor Akbar and Shah Jahan, a **Nazrana Silver Rupee of Katak Mint of Nagpur Bhonsalas**, and some Rare Coins of Marathas, Assam, Cooch Behar, Gwalior, Mysore etc., and last but not least, an exceedingly rare rupee of **East India Company of Saugor (Sagar) Mint.** As usual in **Oswal Auction** there is something for everyone.

The Swastika-type coins were issued by Mahasenapatis/Mahagamikas of the 'Sagama' family or its lesser branch, as evident from coins with full legends. These feudatories accepted a vassal position to the Kshaharata Kshatrapas, when Nahapana penetrated deep into the Deccan during the Satavahana – Kshaharata struggle. The above coin is from a 2020 hoard of Hiranyaka lead coins found in Anantapur region. Out of about 25 inscribed coins, only about 6 had visible legends with Horse symbols and rest were effaced. This is the only known inscribed Bull type coin of the hoard other than the one that was uninscribed. This is believed to be the issue of higher official of the Satavhanas. Unpublished and one of the finest specimens known till date.

38 Kakatiyas of Warangal, Prola I, Gold Punch Marked 2 ½ Gadyana, 9.72g, Uniface, Very huge flan size 64 mm, Total of 32 round punches of varied sizes depending on the motif types, discreetly and deeply struck on a thin flan. 1 x Central punch of Rama-Lakshman standing facing front, with a club in their right arms. Surrounding the central punch, there exist 15 small and uniform sized punches: 2 x "Sri-Sri" in Kannada, 1 x Lenka in Kannada, 1 x Koma in Kannada, 7 x Boar standing facing right with Sun and Moon above, 4 x Seven Petals Lotus. The outer layer circumfluent punches consist of alternately placed 8 X Lion standing facing left with raised forepaw, 8 x Nine Petals Lotus. (Unpublished). Uncirculated, extremely fine.

The above coin is from a 2 year old hoard of few coins found at Warangal. This is the third known Palm sized broad flan Gold coin ever known for the Hindu dynasty. It is a golden and rare opportunity to possess the coin in one's collection, which even the museums do not possess to date. Note: Lenka Koma means Commander-in-Chief of the army. Prola I was the feudatories to the Rashtrakutas and fought several successful wars for his Lord and were allowed to rule the lands in Krishna district that were earlier in the possession of the Nolambas.

39 Kakatiyas of Warangal, Prola II, Gold Punch Marked 1 ½ Gadyana, 5.78g, Uniface, Very huge flan size 50mm, Twenty-three punches discretely and deeply struck on a very thin and broad gold flan, 1 x central punch of the Kakatiya family Goddess Kaakati Devi seated in padmasana facing front with Conch and Discus in her hands. The peripheral punches are stuck in two tiers, the first tier, punches consist of 2 x Kannada letter "Shri Shri", 4 x Lion standing facing left with raised foreleg, 1 x Kannada legend "Raya Gaja" and 1 x Kannada legend "Kesari". The outer tier shows 7 X Boar standing facing left and 7 x Lotus placed alternately on obverse (Unpublished). Uncirculated, extremely rare.

The Kakatiyas succeeded the Nolamba dynasty and ruled for a brief period and their coins were extremely rare. It is only a year ago a small hord of coins surfaced at Warangal. The Kakatiya coins are most desired among South Indian coin collectors.

40 Kakatiyas of Warangal, Prola II, Gold Punch Marked1 ½ Gadyana, 5.77g, Uniface, Very huge flan size 51 mm, Nine punches discretely and deeply struck on a very thin and broad gold flan, 1 x central punch of Lion standing facing right with raised forepaw. The 8 peripheral punches consist of 2 x Kannada letter "Shri", 4 x Lion standing facing left with raised foreleg, 1 x Kannada legend "Raya Gaja" and 1 x Kannada legend "Kesari" on obverse (Unpublished). Uncirculated, extremely rare.

Prola-II was a feudatory to the Chalukya Vikramaditya-VI and proclaimed independence with the decline of the Chalukyas. He extended his kingdom upto Krishna district. The title Rayagaja Kesari is adorned by many of the Kakatiya rulers following Prola-II, but by looking at the composition of the hoard, the coin could be assigned to Prola-II. The peripheral Lion punch is the insignia of the Chalukyas.

41 Western Gangas as feudatories of the Rashtrakutas, Gold Punch Marked Gadyana, repousse fabric, 3.72g, Obv: Nine punches struck deeply on a thin flan, 5 x Elephant standing in profile to right, 2 x Kannada letters "Shri", 1 x Kannada legend "Maara", 1 x Kannada legend "Pathi". Extremely fine, Very rare.

The attribution of these coins is uncertain, but judging by its similarity in fabric and style to the Kakatiya coins, it is plausible to attribute the type to Maraismha II Satyavakya (963-975 AD).

Coins with religious legends form an important and rare aspect of the Bengal coinage, particularly the one struck in the relatively short reign of Jalal al-Din Fath Shah. However, the legends as reported in G&G (as above) are far from certain and particularly the last part of the reverse legend leaves more to be said in terms of which words suit the letterforms best. But it is certain that the legends refer to 'Qadam-i Rasool', or the footprint of the Prophet, with the Sultan naming himself as the Mujawar (close companion or servant) of the shrine.

A belief started early in Islam was that when Prophet Muhammad stepped on a rock, his footprint left an imprint. Orthodox brands of Islam did not accept this belief but the idea was disseminated widely and led to the creation of many shrines around such imprints. Contextually, the practice matches 'footprint worship' in pre-Islamic beliefs such as Buddhism and Vaishnavism. Particularly in the realms of the Sultans of Bengal, such shrines were created by various Sultans at Pandua (Firuzabad), Gaur, Cuttack, Nabiganj and Chittagong (both in Bangladesh). Of these, the one from Pandua dates from the reign of Fath Shah and it is said that the footprint it venerates came from the meditation room (Chilla Khana) of the Sufi establishment of Shaykh Jalal Tabrezi. This Sufi Shaykh played an important role in disseminating of Islam in the Western part of Bengal, and along with Nur Qutb ul-'Alam, he is considered to be a highly regarded Muslim saint. The fact that Fath Shah regards him as a 'servant' and a 'Shaykh' at this shrine is particularly significant because it highlights the Sultan's piety and leaning towards a more non-orthodox version of Islam. The coins with these legends were struck from many mints but they all are very rare. Coins bearing the mint-name 'Khazana', like this one, are known in wide flans and with decorative borders enclosing the legends, so were very likely produced specially, possibly at the inauguration of the shrine in 1485.



This coin is an exceedingly rare type introduced as a short-lived transitional type soon after Central India was consolidated under British rule after the fall of the Marathas (Sindhia and Holkar in this case). The rupees produced at Sagar (Saugor) at this time were Maratha 'Balashahi' rupees but they were quickly imitated by an unofficial mint at Garhakota, producing coins of an inferior standard and thereby causing a lot of confusion in the market. To remedy this, Mr Maddock, the Assistant to the Agent to Governor General, ordered the coinage produced at Saugor to have features such as the name inscribed on them in English and also the date in English numerals, so that they could be easily distinguished from the unofficial, debased copies being produced at Garhakota. Maddock also suggested that the mint be run on a government payroll in order to increase efficiency and production and his suggestion was implemented in 1825.


