- 2 **Punch Marked, Attributed to Shakya Janapada, Silver 5 Shana**, 7.15g, "Narhan Hoard" type, Uniface, bold punch in center, bankers marks around (Hardaker# NH1). *Extremely fine, rare*.
Suddodhana Father of Lord Buddha was chief of Shakya's. Their capital was known as Kapilavastu. Lumbini Vana the birth place of the Lord Buddha can be identified with Rummindei is located around 10 miles to the east of Kapilavastu. *Very fine*.

- 3 **Punch Marked, Tentatively Attributed to Vajji / Malla Janapada, Silver Mashaka**, 0.24g, Single punch type. *Patinated, extremely fine, extremely rare*.
These enigmatic fractional coins surfaced around 2014 and may be tentatively attributed to the Shakya/Malla Janapadas, based primarily on their reported find-spot details, as observed by Sharad Sharma. The distinctive central dot surrounded by four U-shaped symbols (with minor variations) is a motif encountered on several silver and copper coins of the Gangetic plains, including the well-known "Lanky Bull" type of Kaushambi. Considering its small size, fabric and overall characteristics, the coin represents "mashaka" denomination of local type Punch Marked Coin.

Khusrau Khan, originally a Hindu from Gujarat who had been converted to Islam, rose to power after defeating and killing Sultan Qutb al-Din Mubarak Shah of the Khalji dynasty in 1320. He briefly occupied the throne of Delhi for about four months. His accession marked a sharp break with the established political order: he favoured his own supporters, including many converts and non-Turkish groups, and challenged the dominance of the Turkish nobility. His policies also appear to have challenged established practices of religious discrimination and the enslavement of women and captives as war booty. These measures, together with his treatment of the powerful nobles, provoked fierce opposition. Firuz Shah Zafar emerged during the turbulent succession crisis following the death of Sultan Firuz Shah Tughlaq in 1388. He exercised authority for only a very short period, and his reign is consequently among the lesser-known episodes of late Tughlaq history. Nusrat Shah was a later ruler of the declining Tughluq dynasty who emerged during the prolonged struggle for the Delhi Sultanate following the death of Firuz Shah Tughluq. He established his authority at Firozabad and contested the throne with other rival Tughluq princes. His reign coincided with a period of severe political fragmentation, when the once-powerful Sultanate was increasingly divided among competing factions and provincial governors. To this turbulent period, his coins particularly the present coin is only 2nd known example of silver tanks other than Goron & Goenka, and of considerable historical and numismatic importance, representing the final phase of Tughluq monetary issues before the rise of the Sayyid dynasty.

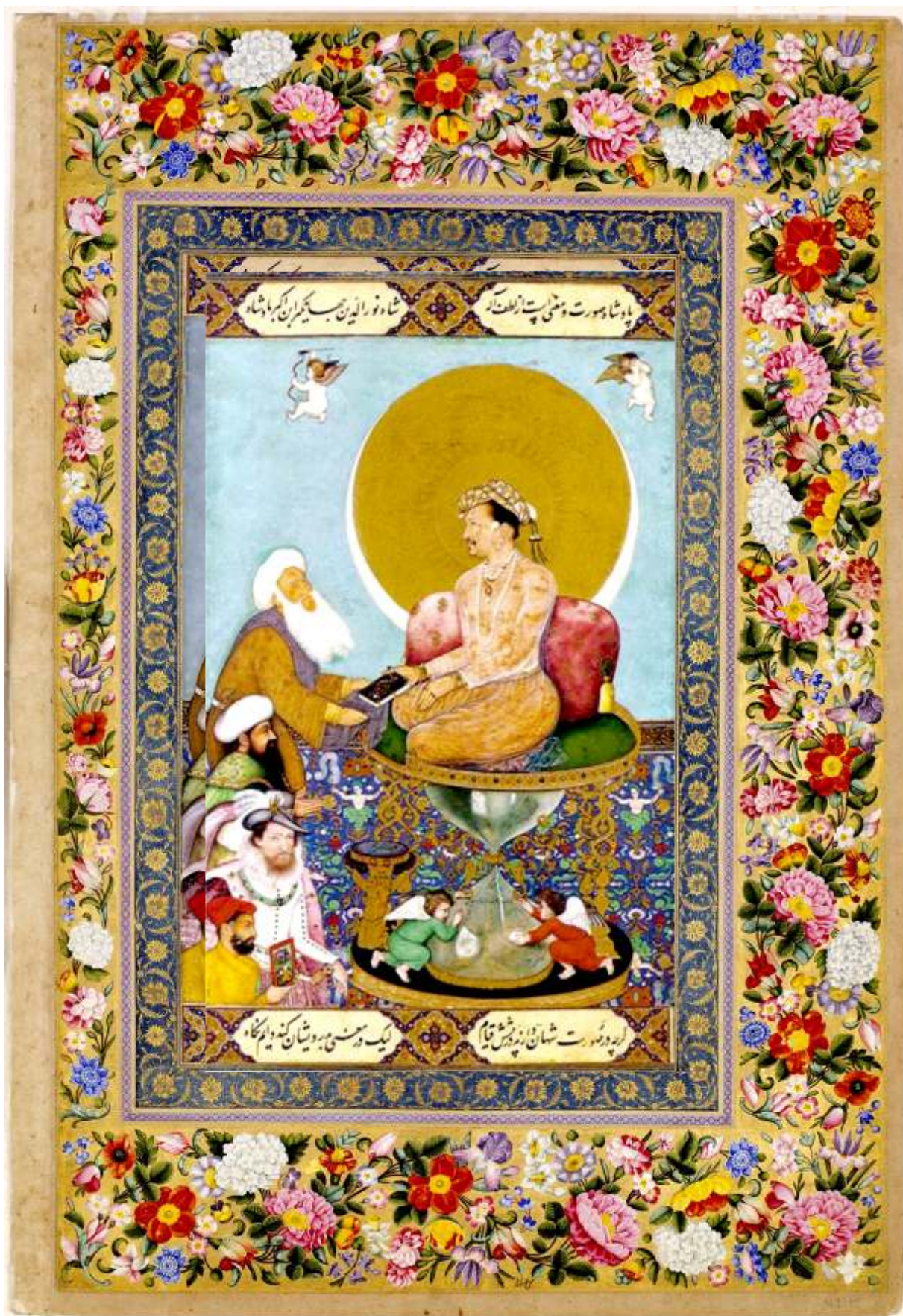

Jahangir showed an intimate affinity towards his coinage, experimenting with great interest with typology, design, weight standards and other visual and circulatory innovations. Soon after his ascent to the throne, he revised the weights of his coins upwards, first by 20% and then by 25%. A series of extremely attractive coins followed from principal mints in the Empire, like Agra and Lahore. For silver rupees, the shape alternated between round and square for each month. However, in his 6th regnal year, on the date 11 Ardibihisht AH1020, the heavier standards were abolished. The most immediate issues after the abolishment were square (the shape current for the month of Ardibihisht) but without the mention of the month. Successive issues, for the next month Khurdad, were round and did refer to the month's name in the legends. The practice of alternating shapes between round and square was then resumed. This coin, of round shape was struck in the month of Bahman of the next regnal year. The design and layout of the type is unusual, with the mint name appearing on the top, and the word 'Ilahi' is inscribed with a short 'i', instead of the usual long-stroked / 'lazy' letter.

It is very rare that a completely new type for a mint under Jahangir comes to light. This coin fits the bill - it is struck at Ahmadabad in a new type for the mint. Along with Jahangir's name, it carries the name of the month (Shahrewar) and the name of the mint, both inscribed within highly ornamented borders. Unusually, the calligraphic style is Nastaliq, when all other coins of Ahmedabad around this time are struck with legends in the Naskhi style.

Jahangir abolished the 25% overweight 'Sawai' standard on 11 Ardibihisht of his RY 6. However, contrary to this order, some mints like Lahore continued striking Sawai coins for some more time. At Agra, a series with ornamental borders that alternated with round and square coins was launched. The feature of ornamental borders and a backdrop of delicate floral decorations for well-executed Nastaliq calligraphy, was also introduced at a few other mints like Lahore, Tatta and Akbarnagar for rupees struck to a normal weight standard. However, it was unknown for Ahmadabad till date.

The changeover of the weight standards from heavy to normal presumably caused some inconvenience as coins struck in the immediate aftermath, bearing months Khurdad to Shahrewar of AH1020/Ry6 are very rare for most provincial mints. The only other mint to have struck coins in type similar to this coin of Ahmadabad in Shahrewar AH 1020/ RY 6 is Burhanpur and these issues are also very rare.

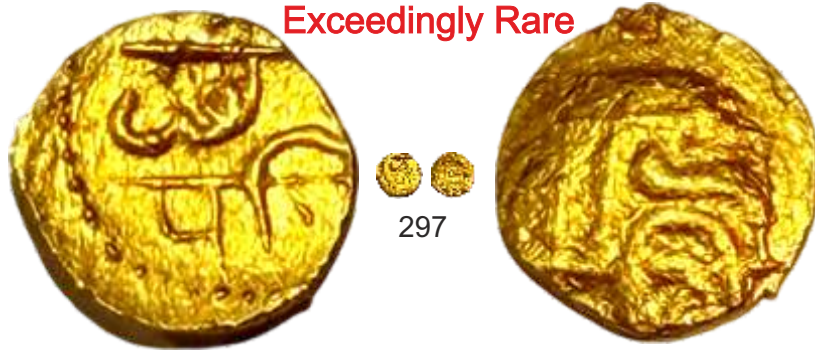

A distinguished soldier, he volunteered for active military service during the Second World War and served in the Middle East with the 2/5th Marathas, attaining the rank of Major. In recognition of his distinguished military career and service, he was gazetted as an Honorary Major-General of the Indian Army in 1962. His life thus combined the traditions of princely leadership, public administration and military service.

Machhlipatan was stormed and taken and a treaty concluded with Salabat Jang in May, 1759, by which the British took control of Machhlipatan and the surrounding area.  Mughal-style rupees were issued from here, with the mint name 'Machhlipatan' from the time of Aurangzeb and continued during the occupation by the British from 1759 (AH 1173) up to 1799 (AH 1215). They had an angular trident as a mint mark.

Only four sets are recorded as having been struck. Another set of these patterns was sold at Baldwin's Auction 71 in September 2011, lot 1609. This set varies from Baldwin's set as it contains two different examples of the rupee coin and one 1/2 Rupee, while Baldwin's set contained only one 1 rupee but two 1/2 Rupees.

India and Pakistan gained independence from British rule in August 1947. The newly founded Pakistan immediately launched its coins in 1948. They were based on designs prepared by Bernard Sinclair-Jones, the British deputy master of Lahore mint. In India, however, the establishment of a Constituent Assembly in 1946 meant that matters relating to national identity were debated seriously, till they were incorporated in the new nation's constitution. As a result, no coins were struck for circulation dated 1948 or 1949. The Constituent Assembly submitted its report in November 1949 and paved the way for India's national coinage. Till then approximately 460 million pieces of the 1946-47 nickel issue apparently sufficed. It was mooted that in 1950, new designs will be introduced.

In 1949, P.W.M (Patrick) Brindley, the master engraver for the Calcutta and Bombay mints, prepared a fine set of pattern designs for the new coinage. It is not known whether final dies were actually prepared for these patterns, or whether the master matrices were used to strike the coins.

Patrick Brindley (1913-1989) succeeded A. P. Spencer as the master engraver of Bombay and Calcutta mints in 1945 and had already worked on the designs for the 1946-47 coins, contributing a graceful roaring tiger for their reverse. For the 1949 designs, he appears to have chosen a melange of Industry, Agriculture and Heritage (natural and man-made) as its main themes.

In spite of the great appeal of the 1949 designs, each was rejected - some, like the inclusion of the bull from the famous Mohenjodaro seal on the 1-anna, for obvious reasons that the site had now passed in Pakistan. However, the design proposed by Brindley for the 1-pice coin eventually appeared on the rupee coins, after some modifications, and his theme of featuring historic heritage also survived with the inclusion of animals from the Ashoka pillar capital.

Brindley continued to work for the Govt of India mint, Bombay till 1960. He then moved to Khartoum, Sudan, returning to Britain in 1964 and afterwards, moved again to Canada. He continued his vocation at the Royal Canadian Mint and designed many Canadian coins. He died in 1989.

The Spink Numismatic Circular of 1954 reports that only four sets of these patterns were struck. Two now exist in a graded state. The second set, originally from the David Fore Collection, has been graded as “restrikes”.
