- 1 Punch Marked, Attributed to Saurashtra Janapada, Silver Karshapana, 0.95g, "Single Punch" type, Obv: Srivatsa in centre other small symbols around, Rev: Traces of other symbol (Rajgor # Series 18). *Extremely fine*.

- 2 Sunga Period, Cast Copper (2), 2.83g, 2.61g, Obv: Elephant walking to left, Rev: Three arched hill with a crescent above & Obv: Tree in railing, Rev: Three arched hill with a crescent above. *Very fine*. 2 coins.

- 3 Khandesh / Tapi Valley, Uninscribed Cast Copper, 2.04g, Uniface, Three arched hill with crescent and a tree-in-railing arranged in a tete-a-beche fashion on obverse. *Very fine, rare*.

These coins were attributed to Taxila due to the fact that similar coins had been found in the excavations. However, in recent years after the contributions of K K Maheshwari who collected them mainly in Hyderabad, their identity as post- Mauryan early uninscribed cast copper series has been established more firmly.

Vrishni coins of this type were first reported by Handa and Swami Omananda Saraswati from sites like Sunet near Ludhiana in Punjab. On the coins published by Handa the legend was not very clear, but here it is clearly read as 'Jayasamstha', with an anuswara on the letter Sa. A number of personal names with highly Sanskritized renderings are known on these coins and Jayasamstha appears to be one of them.

Satyadaman known only from his extremely rare coins. He ruled only for very short period of SE 124/ AD 202. The coins of Satyadaman consider as rarest in the entire Western Kshatrapas series.

These uninscribed coins, known chiefly from North Kashmir, are most likely issues of Pravarasena or Meghavahana from the Hazara region. The frontally shown Vishnu has parallels in Kashmiri images of Vaikuntha whose cult was very popular in Kashmir.






