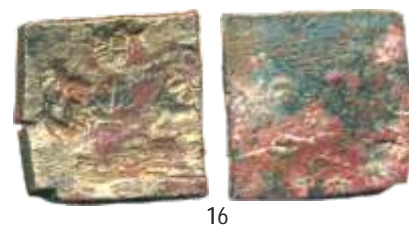
- 11 Punch Marked, Attributed to Ashmaka Janapada, Silver 1/2 Karshapana, 1.40g, Uniface, Four symbol configuration of ABBC type, Elephant, Leaf, Fish and Taurine symbol on obverse (Rajgor # Series 26). *Very fine+, rare.*

Sold ` Estimate: ` 4,000-5,000

- 12 Punch Marked, Attributed to Kashi Janapada, Silver 1 Shana, 0.83g, Middle Ganges Valley, "Repousse fabric" (Rajgor series 53), broken into two but restored using old binding technique. *Extremely rare.*

Coins of this type constitute some of the rarest series of archaic punch-marked coins, often encountered broken because of their thin flans.

- 13 Punch Marked, Attributed to Kosala Janapada, Silver Karshapana, 3.07g, Obv: Elephant to left, English 'S' type symbol & other symbols around, Rev: Various banker mark. (Rajgor Series# 65). *Very fine*.

- 14 Punch Marked, Attributed to Saurashtra Janapada, Silver 1/4 Karshapana, 0.99g, Obv: Elephant walking to right, Swastika, circle, square box and other symbols around, Rev: Swastika, taurine and earlier symbols. *Very fine, very rare*.

- 15 Punch Marked, Attributed to Saurashtra Janapada, Silver 1/4 Karshapana, 0.89g, Obv: Vertical fish, open circle, taurine, triskele and square box around, Rev: Animal with traces of earlier symbol. *Very fine, Rare*.

- 16 Punch Marked, Eran-Vidisha region, Uninscribed Copper Unit, 9.77g, Uniface, Five punches including tree in railing, lotus, Elephant, Indradwaja and river with fishes. *Very fine*.

- 17 Ancient Western Malwa, post-Mauryan period of "Pusyamitra", die-struck, Lead, 17.15g, Obv: Symbolic composition of a bull facing left, a tree-in-railing, a taurine and a triangle-headed standard, Rev: Double wavy line with fishes in between, 'Ujjain' symbol above it, Brahmi legend "Pusami" to left and "tasa" to right.

It is highly possible that these coins may have struck by Great Ruler and Founder of Sunga Dynasty "Pushyamitra Sunga". Scholars have different views on this because of no Royal title attached in legend. Historically very important and extremely rare coin.

- 21 City State, Suktimati, Copper, 3.29g, Obv: Horse facing right, Srivatsa in railing front of horse, Brahmi legend "Sutimati" above, Rev: Elephant walking to right, trunk upraised, front of triangular headed and upward Taurine mark, tree in railing behind Elephant and four orbs above. *About very fine, very rare*.

- 22 Tribal Coinage, The Sibi Janpada, Copper, 5.60g, Obv: Traces of symbols in the centre, Brahmi legend "... (mi)kaya Sibi Janapa...." around, Rev: Six-arched hill with crescent, wavy line below, traces of other symbols around. *Very fine, exceedingly rare.*

- 23 Tribal Coinage, Audumbara tribe of ancient Punjab, Rudradasa, Copper, 2.81g, Obv: Temple with trishul to right, Brahmi legend, Rev: Audumbara tree with elephant to right, *Kharoshthi* legend (HGC 12, 835). Patinated, *very fine for type, very rare.*

- 25 Kunindas, Amoghabhuti, Silver Drachma, 2.18g, "Lakshmi" type, Obv: A deer to right with a female figure standing facing on right, holding flower in uplifted right hand, around Brahmi legend "*Rajnah Kunidasya Amogh [bhutisya]*", Rev: Six arched hill, tree in railing, swastika, nandipad, triangular headed symbol and around *Kharoshthi* legend (D.Handa # Pl. XI-XVIII). *Extremely fine.*

- 26 Pre Satavahana, Vidarbha, Pauni region, Uninscribed Cast Copper, 5.42g, Obv: Bull walking to right, taurine above, Rev: Plain. *Very fine, rare.*
Coins of this peculiar series from Pauni shows a high iron content in the alloy. Whether this was intentional is not known, but most likely they were made from a locally available source of copper ore rich in iron.

- 27 Deccan, Square Cast Copper, 6.43g, Obv: Three-arched hill, hollow cross with in circle, Rev: Uncertain symbol within circle. *Extremely fine.*

- 28 Post Mauryan South Vidarbha, King Sebaka, Copper, 8.21g, "Elephant" type, Obv: Elephant walking to right, Brahmi legend "*(Raño) Sebakasa*" above, Rev: Bold Nandipada drawn with double lines, a circle with Swastikas below to its left. *Very fine+, very rare.*

- 29 Post Mauryan South Vidarbha, King Sebaka, Copper, 10.30g, "Bull" type, Big size, Obv: Bull to right with swatikas, Indra-Dhvaja, six arched hill, Brahmi legend "*Rajno Sebakasa*" above, Rev: Nandipada above double orbed circle, (pieper# 589). Sharp bold strike, *extremely fine+, extremely rare in this grade.*

- 30 Panchala, "Agnimitra", Copper, 2.50g, Obv: Bold square punch, showing three stylized symbols and Brahmi legend "*Agnimitasa*", Rev: Tree in railing and a hill (Mitch 4552). *Very fine.*

- 31 Ancient Maharashtra, Kutapada (?), Alloyed Copper, "Elephant" type, 4.88g, Obv: Elephant standing facing right, river symbol below, Brahmi legend "*Raño (Ku)...*" above, Rev: Tree in the railing, Ujjaini symbol. *Very fine for type, very rare.*

- 32 Pre-Satavahana, Marathwada, Vidarbha, Uninscribed die-struck, Square Copper, 4.03g, Obv: Lion crouching to right below 'Ujjain' symbol and Swastika counterstruck over elephant standing facing, Rev: Tree with delicate leaves flanked by other small symbols like an 'Ujjain' symbol to right and Swastikas above. *Very fine+, very rare.*

- 33 Pre-Satavahana, Marathwada, Vidarbha, Uninscribed die-struck coin, 2.98g, Obv: Elephant standing facing, Rev: Tree with delicate leaves interspersed with small Nandipada symbols, and flanked by other small symbols like an 'Ujjain' symbol to right. *Very fine, extremely rare.*

The coin has an unusually detailed and artistic symbolic program. The depiction of a facing elephant is also highly unusual for a Deccan series of uninscribed coins.

- 34 Pre-Satavahana, Vidarbha Region- Paoni area, Ashvabudha, Punch Marked, Copper, 3.06g, Uniface, Five symbol type, Tree and four orb Ujjain symbol on top, bull and geometric symbol and in centre Brahmi legend "Asubudh" on obverse (Kulkarni ICS News letter No. 41). *Very fine, very rare.*

From Paoni area coins with the ending name "Bhadasa" and "Mitasa" rulers are known but very few specimens are known of ruler Asubudh. *Very rare.*

- 38 Indo Scythians, Azilises, Copper Drachma, 3.63g, Obv: Diademed king on horseback to right with Greek legend, Rev: Heracles seated to left on a rock, holding club on his right knee, with Kharoshthi legend (Bopearachchi & Rehman # 749). *Very fine.*

- 39 Kushans, Kanishka I, Copper Tetradrachm, 14.82g, "Buddha" type, Obv: King standing left, holding standard, sacrificing over altar to left, traces of Bactrian legend, Rev: Maitreya Buddha seated cross-legged facing on stool, one hand raised in gesture of *Abhayamudra* and holding *kaman?alu* (water pot) in the other; Bactrian legend "...O BOU(D)O..." to left and tamgha to right. *Very fine for type, very rare.*

- 40 Satvahanas, Attributed to Siri Satakani, Newase-Paithan region, Heavy Weight Lead Coin, 26.48g, "Gajalakshmi" type, Obv: Goddess Lakshmi, standing on lotus, and being lustrated by elephants on lotus on either side, traces of legend above, Rev: Tree with broad leaves within a railing, ancillary symbols around (MCSI# 139). *Very fine for type, very rare.*

- 41 Satavahanas, Siri Satakani, Khandesh / North Maharashtra region, Copper, 2.75g, Obv: Ujjain symbol in centre, Brahmi legend "Raño Siri Satakanisa" around, Rev: A bold Triratna symbol. A new and previously unpublished type. *Very fine+, very rare.* Similar coins with three-arched hill symbol were previously known, but this is the first example known with a Triratna in its place.

Although the legend on this coin is 'Siri Satakani', the typology and the stylistics indicate that it must have been issued by Gotamiputa Siri Satakani in the late 1st century AD.
