

The first piece was discovered by Dr P L Gupta in the British Museum's collection.





The earliest minting activity on behalf of the Peshwa is known to have been undertaken during the short and ill-fated reign of Peshwa Narayan Rao when Dullabh Set Govindji, a banker of Pune was given a license to operate a mint. The coins he produced were to be rupees and mohurs, to be known as 'Shet shahi' coins after his name. All coins of this early issue are very rare. De Suffren learned of this and surprised the British fleet at anchor in Porto Praya, Cape Verde Islands, on 16 April 1781. 
