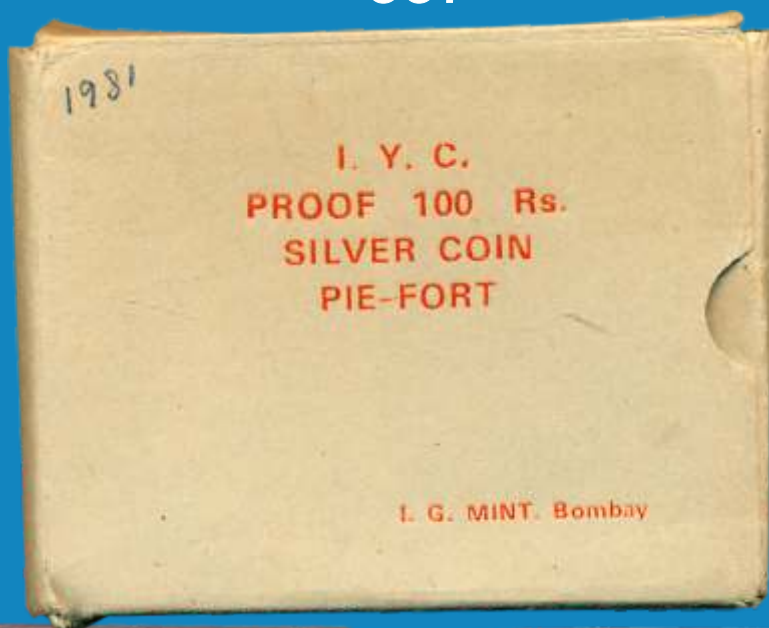

Some traces of an under type visible, Rev: Bull walking to right on top of a rectangular altar (most likely a representation of a Vedic sacrifice), counterstruck on a motif consisting of a river symbol. It is likely that the motif was a Makara, but it has been obliterated by the Bull. *Very fine+, extremely rare*.

A highly unusual and important type of local uninscribed die-struck coinage that evolved in the Deccan after the Mauryan period.

- 37 **Feudatories of Vishnukundins, The Rama-Kashyapa gotri rulers of Pishtapura (Peethapuram, Eastern Andhra Pradesh), Prithvimaharaja**, Alloyed Copper Unit, 3.50g, Obv: Roaring Vishnukundin-style lion facing right, small Shrivatsa above its back and Brahmi legend "**Shri Rama**", Rev: Sankha shell between two lampstands within a rayed circle. *Very fine+, extremely rare.*

The Rama-Kashyapa gotri rulers were part of a confederacy of feudatories set up towards the end of the Vishnukundin rule. They were followed by Eastern Chalukyas of Vengi.

The Kadambas of Nagarkhanda were another scion of the Kadamba dynasty. They claim to be the descendants of Mayuravarma of Hangal, the progenitor of the Kadamba family & in order to show their genealogical connection with the early Kadambas they styled themselves "the boon lords of Banvasi Pura". This was obviously a mere title as they never in continual possession of this city. Their capital was perhaps the city of Bandhavapura, since they claim to be its boon lords. Their personal title seems to be that of mahamandalesvara and their family god was Lord Shiva.

Mahalugi or 'Mahlak Deo' was the last king of the Paramara dynasty of Malwa. So far he is only known for textual information. According to Amir Khusrau's *Tarikh-i 'Alai*, when in 1305, Ala al-Din Khilji the Sultan of Delhi invaded Malwa, 'Rai Mahlak Deo' and his pradhan 'Koka' (Goga) resisted the invasion with a large force of cavalry and infantry. Khusrau states that the Delhi army defeated this Paramara force, and "the earth was soaked with Paramara blood". Mahlak Deo fled to Mandu and the minister Goga was killed in the battle. Ain al-Mulk Multani, the newly appointed Governor of Malwa, was sent to expel Mahlak Deo from Mandu. With the help of a spy, Multani's forces found a way to enter the fort secretly. Mahlak Deo was killed while attempting to flee, on 24 November 1305. The story is also narrated by Jain writer Kakka Suri, in his treatise *Nabhi-nandana-jinoddhara-prabandha* composed in 1336.

This is the first time a coin of Mahlak Deo has come to light. There is no question about its Paramara attribution as it is very much in the same series as other Paramara issues, such as Jayasimha and Gopalavarman. The name 'Mahalugi' is evidently the Deshi origin of Amir Khusrau's Persian version 'Mahlak'.

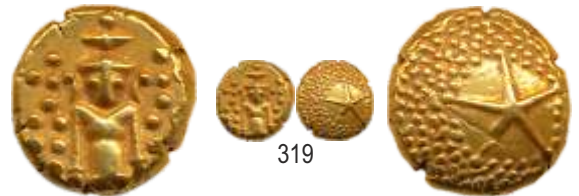

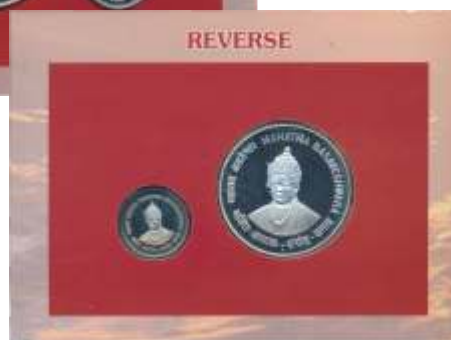

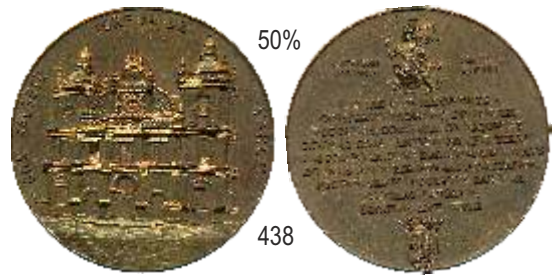
