



A highly unusual and important type of local uninscribed die-struck coinage that evolved in the Deccan after the Mauryan period.

Mahalugi or 'Mahlak Deo' was the last king of the Paramara dynasty of Malwa. So far he is only known for textual information. According to Amir Khusrau's *Tarikh-i 'Alai*, when in 1305, Ala al-Din Khilji the Sultan of Delhi invaded Malwa, 'Rai Mahlak Deo' and his pradhan 'Koka' (Goga) resisted the invasion with a large force of cavalry and infantry. Khusrau states that the Delhi army defeated this Paramara force, and "the earth was soaked with Paramara blood". Mahlak Deo fled to Mandu and the minister Goga was killed in the battle. Ain al-Mulk Multani, the newly appointed Governor of Malwa, was sent to expel Mahlak Deo from Mandu. With the help of a spy, Multani's forces found a way to enter the fort secretly. Mahlak Deo was killed while attempting to flee, on 24 November 1305. The story is also narrated by Jain writer Kakka Suri, in his treatise *Nabhi-nandana-jinoddhara-prabandha* comppsed in 1336.

This is the first time a coin of Mahlak Deo has come to light. There is no question about its Paramara attribution as it is very much in the same series as other Paramara issues, such as Jayasimha and Gopalavarman. The name 'Mahalugi' is evidently the Deshi origin of Amir Khusrau's Persian version 'Mahlak'.





The town of Indore was given the name 'Malharnagar' by Malhar Rao Holkar, the progenitor of the Holkar house which ruled till the merger of the princely state of Indore in India in 1948. The mint at Jaipur became regularly functional towards the end of the rule of Muhammad Shah, so the RY seen on this coin is quite early. It corresponds to 1732-33. There were many important events that took place around this time - Jai Singh II started building his capital city of Jaipur in 1727 and in 1732, he completed several important buildings including the observatory and his palace. In the same year he was appointed the Subahdar of Malwa for the third time and visited Ujjain. In 1734, he performed an 'Ashwamedha' sacrifice. It is likely that this hitherto unknown variety of rupee was struck for one such event. It is also likely that it was perhaps struck, using the Jaipur rupee as a prototype in another Rajput kingdom, such as a thikana of Jaipur. Whichever way, this is an interesting coin for Jaipur enthusiasts.
